Head of Clinical Operations (HCO)

The Head of Clinical Operations (HCO) will be responsible for the development and maintenance of the clinical operations function and for the implementation of all clinical trials.

In this capacity, the HCO will be instrumental in bringing a transformative first-in-class therapy to patients. The HCO manages all aspects of clinical trials and supervises clinical trial managers. The HCO maintains and oversees outsourcing processes and ensures that all clinical project teams work efficiently to achieve company objectives. The HCO manages external consultants and internal resources to set up and maintain a clinical operations function that is efficient and compliant with applicable rules and regulations. This includes the oversight of clinical QA, financial forecasting and reporting, and timeline development and tracking.

The HCO will report to the Chief Medical Officer (CMO) and will manage clinical trial administrative assistants and clinical trial managers.

The ideal candidate would have:

- PhD or master's degree in a relevant field of life science
- 10+ years of pharmaceutical industry experience as clinical trial manager leading international, early- to late-stage clinical trials
- 5+ years of experience as clinical operations manager with line management responsibility for clinical trial managers
- Extensive knowledge of clinical study management, ICH-GCP, relevant regulatory/ethics requirements and clinical/drug development
- Experience in the selection and management of CROs and vendors
- Experience in setting up and overseeing outsourcing processes
- Experience in maintaining and enforcing clinical Quality Assistance (QA) processes
- Excellent interpersonal skills, time management and organizational skills
- Proactive approach, drive and follow-through
- Fluent communication in English, both written and spoken
